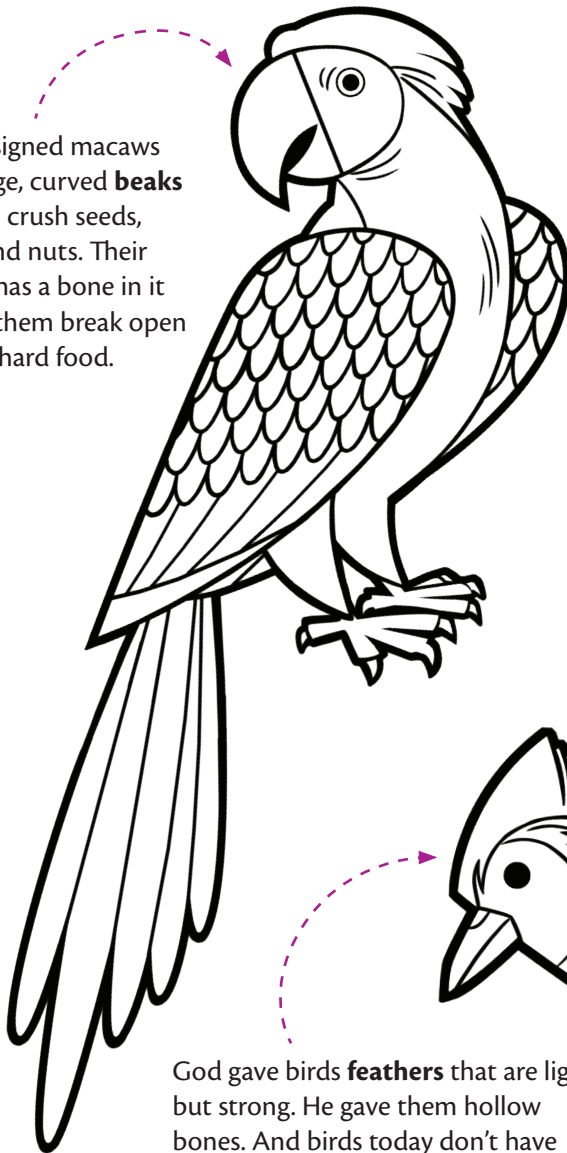

## A CLOSER LOOK AT GOD'S HANDIWORK

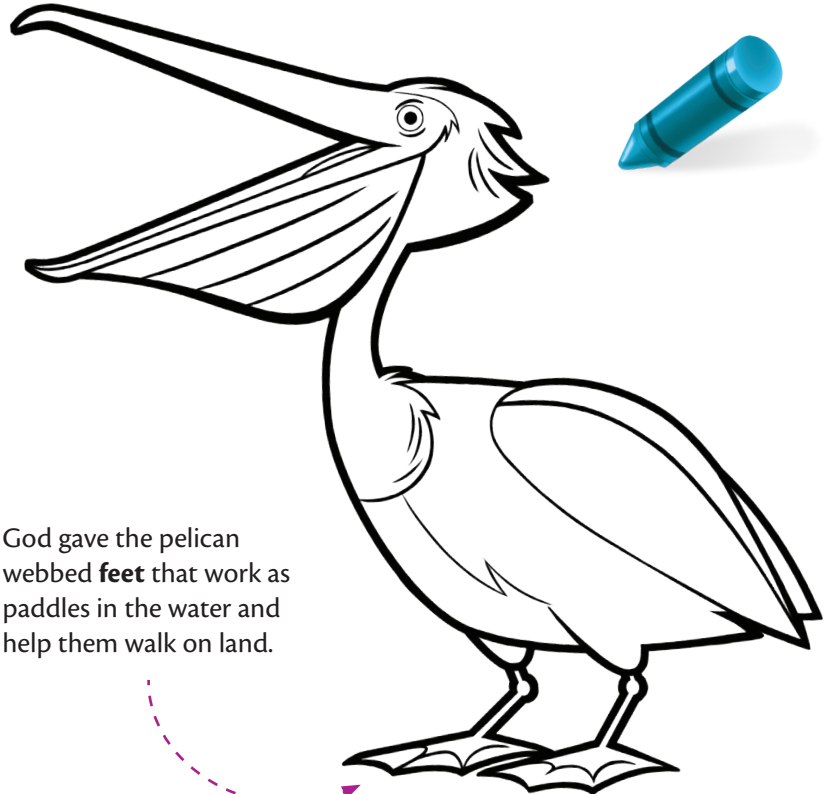
