

What is California's **PROP 1**?

PROP 1 will be on the November 2022 ballot to amend the California Constitution and legalize late-term abortion for any reason during all 40 weeks of pregnancy, **including up to the moment before birth.**

Currently, late-term abortion is prohibited in California unless the procedure is necessary to protect the health or life of the mother, up to the point of viability. Viability means that the fetus could survive outside of the uterus without the requirement for physicians to make extra ordinary medical steps, which is approximately 24 weeks (or six months.)

The language of Proposition 1 is a straightforward three sentences and reads as follows:

“The state shall not deny or interfere with an individual’s reproductive freedom in their most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives. This section is intended to further the constitutional right to privacy guaranteed by Section 1, and the constitutional right to not be denied equal protection guaranteed by Section 7. Nothing herein narrows or limits the right to privacy or equal protection.”

The language of Proposition 1 clearly lacks limits on the time frame in which an abortion can take place during the 40 weeks of pregnancy, including after viability. Without stated time limitations, there are no limitations.
